

# Liver Patient Support



LIVERNORTH is a national liver patient support group and has over 2500 members. Based at the Freeman Hospital Liver Unit in Newcastle upon Tyne, we help liver patients, their carers and families throughout the country and beyond. The Freeman Hospital is a 'centre of excellence' for the treatment of liver disease and has no catchment area for this service i.e. patients are admitted from all parts of the UK and abroad.

LIVERNORTH is a registered charity (no. 1087226) and is run entirely by unpaid volunteers.

We pay no wages, commission, salaries or fees whatsoever to anyone.

Every penny given to LIVErNORTH is used to support liver patients, their carers or families and to fund research into finding cures and treatments for liver disease.

# We provide the following:

- Free information leaflets on most types of liver disease related subjects. These have all been written specifically for us by experts in their field and are a valuable tool in the fight against liver disease.
- A website & social media presence where people can engage with others, find out about the group and download the information leaflets mentioned above.
- Meetings where guest lecturers (usually consultant clinicians) address the meeting and give the latest facts on research into, the causes of and treatments for, liver disease. At the end of every meeting members are given free time with the consultant(s) to ask questions.
- A free quarterly newsletter which keeps members up to date with developments in liver research, treatments and the news and views of patients, consultants and carers. Humour features strongly in the newsletter and many members contribute to the very popular 'Helen's Howlers' column.
- Accommodation at the Freeman Hospital (a 4 bed, 2 bedroom flat) for patients, their carers and families who find travel to & from the hospital too difficult. A minimal charge is made to cover the cost of home comforts such as tea/coffee/TV/microwave etc which are all provided by LIVErNORTH.

- Helplines throughout the region provided by qualified listeners.
- A laboratory at Newcastle University Medical School (The LIVErNORTH Laboratories). Research funded by the group and by others is carried out here to find cures and new treatments for liver disease. Newcastle is a leading centre for liver disease research & treatment in the UK.
- Fund raising events and initiatives (turnover £250k). Our Autumn Fair combined with the Grand Prize Draw and Great North Run raises over £12,000 each year for the group. Promotional items are available at meetings for a small donation and supporters are constantly engaged in fund raising activities for the group. Speakers from the group who give talks to other interested organisations are often given a small fee which is passed on to the group as a donation. Our numbers club has almost 200 members and raises £5000 per year for the group. Coffee mornings etc. raise a further £2000+ per year and general donations make up the remainder.
- Advice and advocacy for members having difficulty with healthcare provision, insurance, allowances or entitlements. The group has governors with legal, medical, social and scientific qualifications.
- Liaison nationally with the Department of Health and regionally with hospitals, clinics, health centres, care providers and other third sector organisations.
- Notice boards where members of the public and carers can obtain information and leaflets are provided at several locations in Hospitals and Liver Clinics throughout the North of England.
- Research Funding <£10k ask for information.

## Liver Disease Facts...

- → There are over 100 known diseases of the liver and only two or three are alcohol related.
- → 90% of people who die from liver disease are under 70 years old.
- → More than 1 in 10 of deaths of people in their 40s are from liver disease, most of them from alcoholic liver disease.
